PAYMENT OF FEES

TUITION (All Students)
\$50.00 per course

FLBI encourages total payment of tuition upon enrolling each trimester. However, if you are not able to afford a one lump sum payment, you can make use of our budget payment plan. FLBI's budget payment plan requires 1/2 of the tuition upon registration. The balance of the tuition is due in two successive monthly payments for that trimester. Admittance to class may be denied if payment is not made on time. Refunds to tuition will only be made on a pro rata basis for classtime not attended, up through the fourth week of class.

Faith by Line & Precept – 1st Year Course

This course will provide the student with a complete study of faith, from both the Old and New Testaments, so that one can gain an understanding of the significance of living by faith as a Christian and as a minister of the Gospel.

Theology – 2nd Year Course

This course provides a systematic approach to the theology of the Bible to be used as a guide for the lifelong journey of “rightly dividing the Word of God” (2 Timothy 2:15).

Dynamics of Healing – 1st Year Course

To lay the scriptural foundation for healing available to New Testament believers; to teach the use of faith as the means of walking in divine health.

Tues, 7:00pm

Ministerial Training – 2nd Year Course

To lay a biblical foundation of ministerial training for believers intent on fulfilling their calling in the Body of Christ.

Tues, 8:15pm

New Testament Living – 1st Year Course

To instill biblical truths and practical implementation on lifestyle for believers.

Helps Ministry – 2nd Year Course

To fully develop a scriptural understanding of Helps Ministry.

Thurs, 7:00pm

Blood Covenant – 1st Year Course

To bring a working biblical knowledge of the Blood Covenant into view for practical application by a believer.

Thurs, 7:00pm

Ministry of Christ – 2nd Year Course

Using Biblical topics to detail the Ministry of Jesus Christ in all aspects.

Thurs, 8:15pm

New Testament Survey – 1st Year Course

A concise overview of each book of the New Testament; designed to expand the student’s concept of the complete work that Jesus began here on the earth.

Thurs, 8:15pm

Financial Redemption – 2nd Year Course

Biblical foundation for deliverance from Poverty. Keys to living in Abundance.

God’s Will for Your Financial Life – 1st Year Course

To lay a scriptural foundation for a believer’s life.

The New Man – 2nd Year Course

To provide a scriptural base, in a teaching format, for the Pauline Revelation, instruct in the practicality of “walking in the New Man”, and illustrate from the New Testament “what God hath wrought in Christ.”

Eschatology – 1st Year Course

To teach the scriptural truth of the end times, emphasizing the time of the Rapture of the church through the establishment of the New Jerusalem. The course includes both doctrinal and chronological elements, as presented in the Bible.

Practicalities of the Ministry – 2nd Year Course

To impart a general scriptural understanding of the practical and natural side of the ministry of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Spiritual Warfare – 1st Year Course

Instructs and guides a believer in spiritual warfare from a novice position, all the way to “comfortable veteran”.

Local Church Ministry – 2nd Year Course

To establish a biblical perspective of the birth, structure, and operation of the local church and to replace traditional opinion with Bible truth in the life of the local church.

Following Jesus – 1st Year Course

To lay a biblical foundation for the student and all believers to make right choices.

Ministry Callings – 2nd Year Course

To instill the Biblical basis for God’s building of the church.

Old Testament Survey: Pentateuch & History – 1st Year Course

This is a survey course designed to present an overview of each Old Testament book from Genesis through Esther, and how they relate to each other and to you as a Christian.

Servanthood – 2nd Year Course

To obtain a Biblical understanding of servanthood, and to learn the difference between slavery and service.

Realities of Redemption – 1st Year Course

Covers vital specifics of redemption, which is important to all believers.

New Testament Prayer – 2nd Year Course

To instill a biblically based, New Testament basis, for a successful prayer life.

Righteousness – 1st Year Course

To lay the scriptural foundation of man’s need for righteousness, and God’s means of providing righteousness for man.

Leadership Training – 2nd Year Course

To lay a biblical foundation for leadership.

Old Testament Survey: Poetry & Prophets – 1st Year Course

This is a survey course designed to present an overview of each Old Testament book from Job through Malachi, how they relate to each other, and how they relate to you as a Christian.

The Christian Family – 2nd Year Course

To teach the student about God’s plan for the family. It emphasizes the significance of submitting the whole family to the Word.

The Ministry of the Holy Spirit – 1st Year Course

The purpose of this course is to teach the student about the mission and the operation of the Holy Spirit in the earth and to the Church.

Forgiveness & Judgment – 2nd Year Course

To teach the student about God’s divine mercy and forgiveness through the saving grace of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Study of Romans – 1st Year Course

To instill an appreciation for great Bible truth. (It is said in literary circles that the Book of Romans ranks at the top of works done by man. We know it to be given by the inspiration of the Holy Ghost.)

Study of Hebrews – 2nd Year Course

To equip the students of this course with the Book of Hebrews, giving them a “working knowledge” of the biblical truths laid out in Hebrews.
